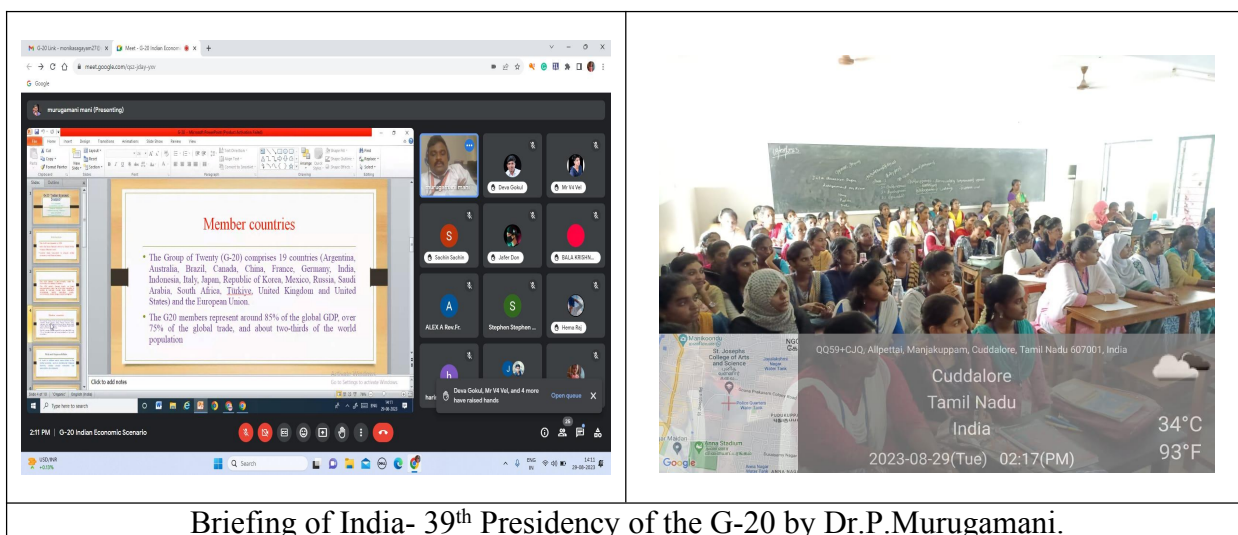

Objectives of the Programme


- To educate the students about India's G20 Presidency- Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam

The session started with a brief introduction about the group of 20 countries (G20) which is the premier forum for international economic cooperation which plays an important role in shaping and strengthening global architecture and governance on all major international economic issues. The session extended towards the theme of India's G20 Presidency highlighting the role of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Start-up to achieve the goals. The resource person illustrated India's research, innovation, start-up achievement and potential and how India can contribute to the G20 sustainable development

The resource person further explained the theme of India's G20 Presidency- "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" which mean "One Earth One Family-One Future" which closely ties with LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) with a focus on sustainable and environment-friendly lifestyles, harmony within the human family, honest conversations about climate change and global security.

India, as the G20 President, will prioritize a range of issues in diverse sectors, including education, energy, agriculture, trade, digital economy, health, environment, employment, tourism, anti-corruption, and women's empowerment. The presidency is expected to have a significant impact on intergovernmental policy and global economic agenda post-pandemic.

Education is a priority area for India's G20 presidency, with a focus on foundational literacy and numeracy, lifelong learning, inclusive and collaborative technology-enabled learning and strengthening research and innovation through collaboration. India's recent Lunar mission "Chandrayaan-3" and the upcoming Solar mission "Aditya - L1", India's most trusted start-ups Cred, Meesho, Groww, Nykaa, Swiggy were cited for illustration.
