- A strong and sound family environment is must for the children to educate Sex Education and sex education needs to begin at home.
- At individual, institutional, and societal levels, developing awareness about Child Sexual Abuse and empathy towards victims is necessary to enhance healthy behaviour, responses, and societal change.
- Training on Teaching Pedagogy for imparting Sex education is needed.
- Training for developing teachers' personality towards imparting sex education needs to be focused.
- Policy making on Sex education needs to be emphasized.
