In the evening session on "Awareness on Importance of Education" was conducted. Mr. A. John Pradeep Ebenezer, Head, Department of Computer Applications of our college was the chief guest. He interacted with children by visualizing some pictures and asked questions from that pictures. He distributed gifts to the children and prizes to the winners of the sports which were conducted on that day. After this, the cultural programme was presented by the students.



Day 4:
