It will create a good behavioral change in the student's personality. It will give a good overlook about the old age of an individual when they need it.

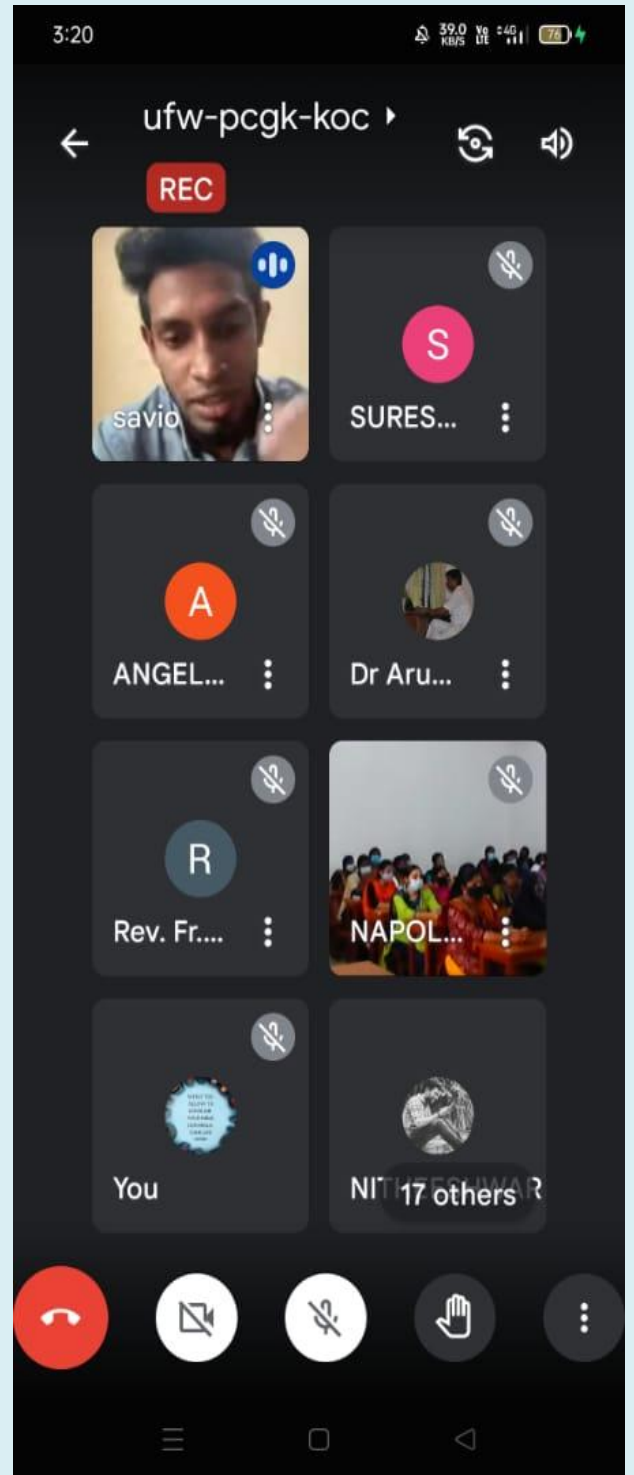
Blood Donation: Imparting the knowledge of blood donation by organizing some programmes.
